Recommended treatment of:

Prevention and treatment of scurvy; acute deficiency of Vitamin C and when the absorption of orally ingested ascorbic acid is uncertain; mild deficiency such as faulty bone and tooth development, gingivitis bleeding gums, and loosened teeth; febrile states, chronic illness, and infection (pneumonia, whooping cough, tuberculosis, diphtheria, sinusitis, rheumatic fever, etc.); hemovascular disorders, burns, delayed fracture and wound healing

Route of administration:

i.v.; i.m.; subcutaneous

Active principle:

Ascorbic Acid
